Each SHS student and guest will be responsible for his/her behavior while in attendance at the dance; SHS officials reserve the right to ask students/guests to leave the dance if they deem behaviors are contrary to school rules or state law, or are unsafe.

Dance Guests

Dances at Sequim High School are intended to be an opportunity for the students of Sequim High School to come together for a positive social event. In an effort to promote togetherness and in support of the educational mission of Sequim High School, the following guidelines will apply with respect to guests at any dances:

Students who wish to bring a guest must have a completed School Dance Guest Form submitted to the SHS Office by the deadline

To be considered for guest status:

- -- must be enrolled in a 9th -12th grade educational program, or be within a year of high school graduation, and may not exceed 20 years of age.
- --must have submitted their completed form to the main office **by 3pm on April 26.** Approval is required before tickets can be purchased. **No guest forms will be accepted at the door.**

To enter the dance:

- --must provide a government-issued photo ID (e.g., driver's license, school ID, state ID) to be admitted into the dance
- --must have advance tickets and approval

All guests agree to follow the rules of Sequim High School.

**Attending an SHS dance is a privilege. If a guest is removed from a dance due to inappropriate behavior, they will not be allowed to attend future SHS dances. Any sponsor of a guest will not be allowed to attend the next SHS sponsored dance.

DANCE GUIDELINES:

Dances sponsored by SHS are intended to be opportunities for students to come together for a positive social event. Our school policy, written in the handbook, gives clear definitions for what is and is not appropriate behavior at these dances:

- Admittance to all dances will end 45 minutes after the start time.
- Students will not be permitted to re-enter the dance after they have left.
- Students and guests must be in possession and provide an ASB card, student identification card, or picture identification.
- Students may not bring backpacks in the dance area.
- All rules and regulations pertaining to school also apply at dances. Under this heading school dress would apply.
- Dancing policy "Face to Face, leave some space" will be strictly enforced.
- Public display of affection ~ Inappropriate displays of affection are not acceptable. Some students are dancing in styles that are not acceptable. No dirty dancing, grinding, freaking, moshing, etc. will be permitted. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
- Occasionally, a friendly reminder is needed that this is a school function and not a dance club (a 'strike'). The 'three strikes rule' will apply to all students; three warnings about inappropriate behavior will result in removal from the dance, parent contact, and loss of the privilege to attend the next SHS sponsored dance.
