

NOTICE OF HIV/STD PREVENTION EDUCATION CLASS

Dear Parent/Legal Guardian:

In response to the growing threat of HIV to our population, the 1988 Washington State Legislature mandated that a program of prevention education be presented to students yearly, beginning with the 5th grade. The Sequim School District #323 has adopted an appropriate program for HIV/AIDS prevention education with the advice of educators, parents, and community members. This is a graduation requirement and includes students in the Running Start program (alternative essay information is available in the Sequim High School Office).

Sequim High School 9-12th grade students will be attending an HIV/AIDS class on Monday Feb. 4th, 2019. The HIV/AIDS class will be taught in your student's DEN class.

Two parent preview meetings were held in October 2018, to allow parents to preview the curriculum. State law provides that a parent or guardian must attend such a meeting before they can have their child or legal ward excused from participation in the HIV prevention program.
