### The School and the Community

Sequim High School is a public four-year high school. It has an enrollment of nearly 900 students, and is the only high school serving Sequim, a city of approximately 6,900 residents located on the Olympic Peninsula of Washington State. An additional 27,000 people live in the surrounding Sequim-Dungeness Valley. For students who seek an alternative setting, the Sequim Options School, associated with Sequim High School, offers opportunities for credit recovery and self-paced instruction. For students who seek access to college-level courses, Running Start, a joint program between Sequim High School and Peninsula Community College, allows qualified juniors and seniors to earn both college and high school credits concurrently. For students who seek occupational training, the Sequim High School campus offers vocational classes to introduce students to a variety of career options. Students served by the Sequim School District can choose to take classes from not only Sequim High School but also any combination of the Sequim Options School or Running Start.

### College Eligibility & Selection

Sequim High School 2017 Graduates: 35% were accepted to a 4-year college; 45% attended a community college.

### Graduation Requirements

Sequim High School operates on a traditional two-semester system with a six-period day and grants credit on that basis. By earning a grade of “D” or higher, students accumulate .5 credit per class per period per semester. Our GPA is unweighted. Our graduation requirements vary based on the students graduation year.
