- **Feiro Marine Life Center Scholarship** ~ For seniors planning to pursue any type of education after high school. Interest in Marine Science is NOT a requirement. Deadline: 1/15/19
- **Kelly Foundation \$2,500 Scholarship** ~ For seniors who demonstrate good citizenship along with a strong academic record. Deadline: 3/10/19
- **Olympic Peninsula Art Association Scholarship** ~ For seniors who plan to pursue a career in Art. Deadline: 4/6/19
- **Blue Whole Gallery Shirley Foss Scholarship** ~ For artistic seniors who plan to pursue a degree/certification (Does NOT need to be an Art Major). Deadline: 4/12/19
