Hello Senior Parents and Guardians,

June 14<sup>th</sup> is quickly approaching, and time will fly after Spring Break. Enjoy these last two months, as there will be many memorable activities. Please continue to watch for the Senior Newsletter information as we finalize our ceremonies to celebrate the Class of 2024.

The Class of 2024 will have their graduation ceremony outside at stá?čəŋ Stadium, rain or shine. The ceremony will begin at 6:00pm on Myron Teterud's Football Field. Each senior will be given 10 (ten) tickets for family and friends. The tickets will guarantee a seat for the ticket holder. Seats will be available in the stadium bleachers with additional chairs on the track and field. There will be wheelchair seating available for those who need additional assistance. Please see the Ticket Distribution section in the newsletter for more specific information about graduation tickets.

It is important for seniors to understand that they must have ALL their graduation requirements completed to be able to walk in the ceremony. These requirements include all credits, High School and Beyond Plan, Graduation Pathways, and HIV/AIDs assignment. If you have any questions about these requirements, please contact your student's school counselor. Additionally, all fines must be cleared before a student can participate in the graduation rehearsal. We have two mandatory graduation rehearsals. The first one is June 13<sup>th</sup> beginning at 12:00pm (noon), on the football field. The second rehearsal is scheduled for Friday morning starting at 9:00am on the football field. Students who plan on walking in graduation must attend both graduation practices. Please speak with me directly if your student cannot attend these mandatory rehearsals.

Every effort is made by our counseling staff and teachers to ensure that seniors and families are informed of current grades and credit status. However, the ultimate responsibility for passing each class and achieving all the required graduation requirements lies with each student.

The end of senior year is one of the most memorable times of your life. Please take advantage of all the wonderful opportunities and finish your last two months at Sequim High School strong!

#### **Daily Bulletin**

The high school bulletin is posted daily on the high school website at <a href="www.sequimschools.org">www.sequimschools.org</a> All seniors should be checking the bulletin daily for events and schedule changes at the high school. This is especially important at this time of the school year. You don't want to be left out!

#### **Senior Final Transcripts**

Most colleges, universities, and technical institutes require a final, official transcript from applicants sometime after completion of second semester. Final transcript requests see Ms. Lepisto in the counseling office. **Parents may not request the final transcript.** 

#### Fines Cleared ~ June 7 Deadline

Seniors must have all fines cleared by **Friday**, **June 7**. The list will be posted on the front office window and is updated regularly. Please be sure and check for your name.

#### **Immunizations**

Many of you who are continuing your education will need access to your immunization records, as they are required by colleges and universities. Additionally, some employers in your future might also request this information. The **Washington State Immunization Information System** (IIS) allows you and your family to access this information at any time it is needed. State requirements have changed and accessing your records from **MyIR** (see sign up process on the Health Services webpage: <u>Vaccines Required for School Attendance - Sequim School District (sequimschools.org)</u>) will make sure you have your records in the required format.

#### Caps & Gowns

The "on-time" graduation orders, cap and gowns will be distributed on Wednesday, April 24. Ones that did not get picked up will be held in the main office. Students who have not ordered a cap and gown and wish to participate in the graduation ceremony must call **National Achiever** immediately at <u>1-800-800-4083</u>. The Counseling Office has a few formerly used gowns for students who need assistance. <u>Reminder</u>: The cap, tassel, sash, and gown are yours to keep.

#### **Ticket Distribution**

**Ten (10) tickets** will be distributed to each participating (walking) senior (if all fines/fees have been cleared) from the main office beginning **Wednesday**, **June 12**, (Sorry, family & friends are not allowed to pick up tickets.) Seniors need to come into the main office and sign for their set of tickets. No tickets will be given to students other than those seniors **walking in the graduation ceremony**. \*\*Note—tickets get you in the gate when they open at 5pm, at 6pm anyone (ticket or not) may enter.

#### **Graduation Rehearsals**

Rehearsals for graduation will be **Thursday**, **June 13** from **12:00** to approximately **2:00pm** and **Friday**, **June 14**, from **9am** to approximately **12pm** at the stadium. Be sure to bring your cap and gown for Friday's rehearsal (Do not bring tassels). **SHS**, **Running Start**, and **DVS students are required to participate in rehearsals** – All fines must be cleared before this time; attendance will be taken. **See Ms. Fox for any emergency absence.** 

#### **Running Start Verification Forms**

**Senior Running Start** verification forms are due by Friday, May, 31. If Running Start courses are needed for graduation, this form will be mailed home. If this form is not returned by May 31. you will **not** walk at graduation.

#### **Diplomas**

The diploma cover handed out during the ceremony will be empty. Seniors may pick up their actual diploma at the District Office in July. Running Start seniors who are completing graduation requirements spring quarter may pick up their diplomas in July the District Office. **PARENTS: PLEASE ENCOURAGE YOUR SENIOR STU- DENT TO TURN IN ALL SCHOOL ISSUED BOOKS AND MATERIALS. #### **End of Year Medication Pick up**

If your student has medication in the nurse's office at school or on the bus, you must pick up <u>all</u> medications from your school's health room office at the end of their school year. Medications in the Health Room may be picked up on Tuesday June 18<sup>th</sup> until 11:30am. \*\*Bus Medications: You will not be able to get the "bus medications" from your student's bus driver. If your student has medications on their school bus, those medications will be delivered to each school's health room on Wednesday, June 19<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am to be available for pick up until 12:00 noon that day only. Any that are left after 12:00 on June 19th will be discarded.

Senior Ball is Friday, May 17, at the Hood Canal Vista Pavilion. Tickets will go on sale April 8 and be \$50 for SHS Seniors



and \$55 for guests. Prices will increase by \$5 each consecutive week, so get your tickets early. Dance guest request forms are available in the main hallway and online. ALL non-SHS seniors must have a guest request and request forms must be completed and turned in before a ticket can be purchased for your guest. Last day to purchase tickets is Friday, April 26. No tickets can be purchased beyond Friday, April 26th because dinner is a catered event and meals are ordered by ticket purchases. Students will ride buses to and from the venue. More detailed information will follow.

- WAVE Scholarship ~ Scholarship amounts vary depending on the recipient's education costs, including college attended, number of credits taken, and other financial aid received. Recipients will be awarded up to approximately \$3,800 per year for up to two years. Must be planning to attend a community or technical college in WA. - Sequim Realtors Association Scholarship Award scholarships to students who are 2024 graduates from the Sequim School

- Olympic Driftwood Sculptors Scholarship This applies to current 12th grade Visual Art students at any public, private, or homeschool on the North Olympic Peninsula. To be eligible, the student must major or minor in visual arts which can include Studio Art (2D or 3D), Photography, Graphic Design, Computer Graphics, Animation, Multimedia, Art Education, Game Design. Architecture, Interior Design, and Fashion Design. Submit the application and examples of their art. Pick up an application in the counseling office. \$1,000 scholarship Due Date: May 12, 2024.
- Larry Jensen Memorial Scholarship Graduating Seniors who are immigrants or whose parents are immigrants. Students must reside in Jefferson or Clallam county. Come to the counseling office for application requirements. Due June 1, 2024
